DIAMOND VALLEY LAKE, Calif.—Another Father's Day tie just doesn't come close to thanking dads for all they do. In recognition of the special day, the marina also will have barbeque, live music, free boat rides, t-shirts and fishing clinics throughout the day. Other prizes include rod and reel packages and gift certificates to local merchants.
